



## **Special Location Searches:**

The advanced search features include several special location search options you can use to tailor your farm to very specific specialized areas.




## **Before You Begin:**

These filters are county specific and apply only when searching within a single county.

## **Functionality**

All the special location searches except for Appraisal District use the same functionality. The screenshot shows the HOA filter but the steps are the same for any of the special location search options.



- Enter at least three letters into the search field (1).
- The filter will auto populate the list with matching entries (2).
- From the list (3), click on one or more matches to move the entry to the Selected list (4).
- You may click Select All (5) or Clear All (6) as required.
- When you have built your list, click the Apply button (7) to add it to the filter.


## **Examples**

The following screenshots demonstrate the different location filters.

**Appraisal District** is used in Oregon and Washington states. The entry is a numeric value.

The screenshot shows a filter set for Yakima County Washington.

Regardless of which location filters you add, all other filters are still available for your farm.




**Appraisal District**, Property Characteristics, and Equity


Note the decrease in record count by adding the property characteristics and equity.



#### High School, Land Use, and Sale Information




#### By Neighborhood and Last Sale




**Subdivision Only**. Note that several variations of the name are present.
